Fertiliser Logistics, Port Handling Operations and Coastal Shipping



The Fertiliser Association of India, New Delhi, organized a program on **Fertiliser Logistics, Port Handling Operations and Coastal Shipping** at Anjar, Kachchh, Gujarat, during 16-19 June 2025. Mr. Parag Saxena, Chief (Marketing), FAI, New Delhi briefed about the objective of the program. After the inauguration, Mr. T.G. Kallingal, Senior Executive Director, IFFCO, New Delhi, made a presentation on Infrastructure at Ports - Factors in Deciding a Discharge Port.
