

From Farm to Fuel : Building a Bio-energy Ecosystem

DG, FAI, in his address, covered the areas related to theme of the Seminar such as collaborative and concerted efforts towards utilization of bio-energy sources having substantial potential due to large agricultural base and generation of agri,-based straw/residues; ways and means to improve bio-diversity of soil; encouragement of integrated nutrient supply system comprising fertilisers, bio-fertilisers, organic sources, recycling of agricultural residues back to soil to improve physical, chemical and biological properties of soil, nutrient use efficiency, organic carbon, microorganisms; management strategies for minimizing burning of Parali through in-situ soil incorporation, bio-decomposer (Pusa decomposer), and converting it into value added products such as fuel, biogas, etc.; Government efforts to bring organic carbon enhancer from compressed bio-gas plants in Schedule VIII of FCO 1985 to promote fermented organic manures and liquid fermented organic manures in agriculture; use of banana as source of K; etc. He replied the queries of the farmers suitably.
