INTRODUCTION

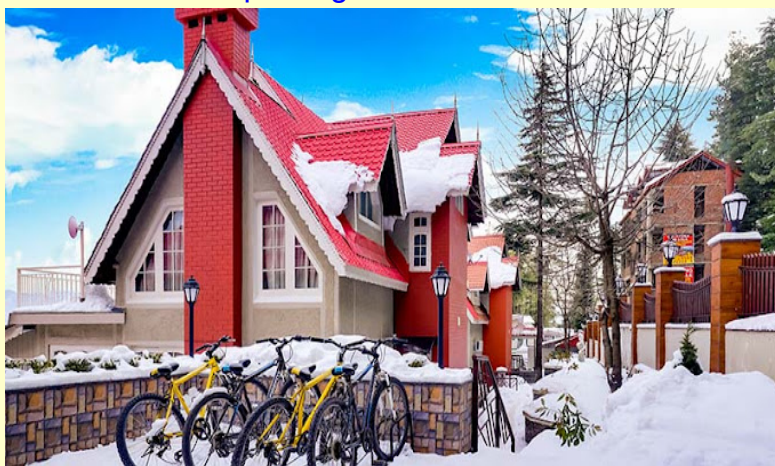
ADDITIONAL PERSON

CONNECTIVITY

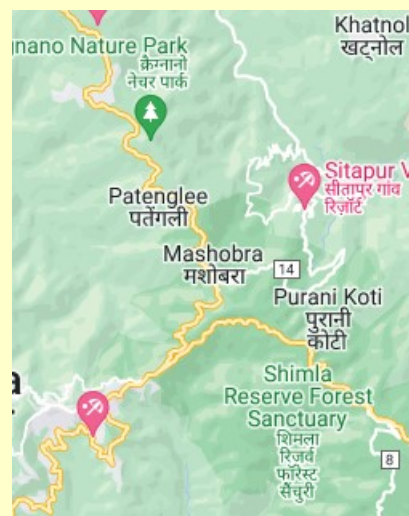
Mashobra (Shimla) is very well connected by Road, Air and Train.

By Road - Distance from Delhi to Mashobra by road is 418 km; Chandigarh to Mashobra is 126 km and Shimla to Mashobra is 13 km. There are direct buses from Delhi, Jaipur and

Chandigarh to Shimla, and then one can avail the facility of private taxis to reach Mashobra.

By Air - The nearest Airport is Jubbarhatti, 34 km from Mashobra. There is a flight from Delhi to Shimla (Jubbarhatti) Airport.

By Train - Kalka (nearest Railway Station), taxis ply to Mashobra (4 hours, 103 km).
